The Delaware League kicked off the 2025 season with a league wide trail work day at Lums Pond State park. With the help of Lums Pond State Park, the Friends of Lums Pond, and the Trail Spinners IMBA Chapter, the Delaware League was able to log over 180 hours of trail work to help clean up the park. Student athletes participated by clearing trail with tools and skimming the pond edge on kayaks and in waders.

Trail work continued throughout the 2025 season with work impacting Longwood at Granogue, White Clay Creek, Middle Run Valley, Naylors Mill, Fair Hill NRMA, and Brandywine Creek State Park. The Delaware League has it's sights set on hosting a trail work series in 2026 to engage new land owners and communities.

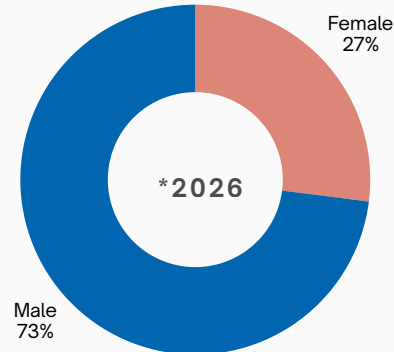
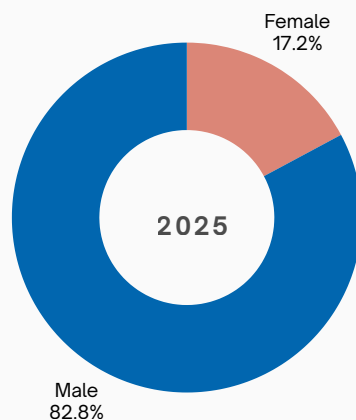
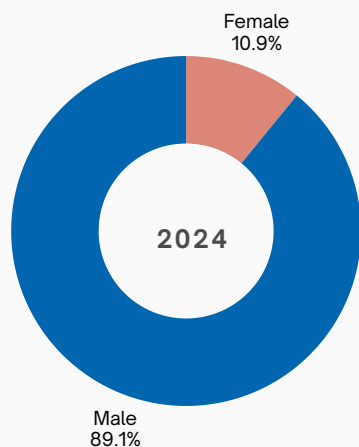

The Delaware League increased efforts in 2025 to deepen female participation across our league. In addition to new recruitment efforts, the Delaware League hosted a preseason GRIT Camp at Montchanin Trails, and offered female specific programming both on and off the bike at all 5 league events. The Delaware League has seen positive growth in our GRiT community over the past two years and is looking forward to continuing conversations to develop a female only school based team in 2026.

In 2025 two organizations came together, Project Seed and Pedal with Purpose, to form **Project Pedal**, a community based team serving youth from the Garfield Park PAL center and along the route 9 corridor.
